PROCEDURES FOR EVALUATION AND REVISION

Because students, community and business profiles and needs are changing faster than at any other time in our history, the Caruthersville Missouri Schools A+ Partnership Plan will be under continued review and revision. In order for the CHS A+ Partnership Plan to work effectively, it is imperative that the views of all community representatives (including students, parents, post-secondary representatives, Caruthersville School District #18 Administration and Faculty, as well as representatives from Business and Industry keep open communications.

To ensure the Caruthersville High School A+ Partnership Plan will remain an effective part of our educational process, mechanisms for receiving information, reviewing and revising the CHS A+ Partnership Plan have been established. The evaluation process will include three primary components:

- 1. Throughout the academic year, the Caruthersville High School A+ Coordinator, in cooperation with the CHS Guidance Counselor and Administration will be responsible for gathering data related to the implementation of each proposed activity as well as the changing student and community profiles. Activity data will include date of implementation, supervision, participation, frequency of A+ student activities, follow-up statistics and requirements as outlined by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education Department, Division of School Improvement, A+ Department. Profile information will be drawn from Student Community Interest Assessments and Continuing Education Needs Assessment conducted a minimum of every (5) years.**
- 2. Subcommittees and/or activity supervisors who will be directly involved in planning, implementing, and supervising the proposed activities will provide information on overall effectiveness, accomplishments, concerns, and possible spin-off activities.**
- 3. The A+/CTE Advisory Committee, which will include representatives from teachers, counselors, administrators, parents, businesses, community leaders, labor, and senior citizens, will serve as the review board for the Caruthersville High School Missouri A+ Partnership Plan. As the CHS A+ Partnership Plan is evaluation each school year, consideration of information will be based on three data sources: historical data from presented on behalf of the Caruthersville School District #18 core data, information from administration and policy changes, and the insight that the A+/CTE Advisory Committee brings as representatives of the community. Using the collected data, the A+/CTE Advisory Committee will make recommendations for revision to the A+ Partnership Plan.**
- 4. Those recommendation will be presented to the Caruthersville Board of Education for approval. Authorized changes will be implemented during the following academic year.**
